

# Provider access policy statement

### Introduction

This policy statement aims to set out our school's arrangements for managing the access of education and training providers to students for the purpose of giving them information about their offer. This complies with the schools legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997

### Pupil Entitlement

- To understand how to make applications for a full range of academic and technical courses

The school and sixth form will also make available AV and other specialist equipment to support the provider presentations. This will be discussed and agreed in advance of the visit with the Careers Lead.

Providers are welcome to leave a copy of their prospectus or other relevant course literature at the Careers office which is managed by Simon Farmer our Careers Advisor.

Our safeguarding/child protection policy outlines the school's procedure for checking the identity and suitability of visitors.


Education and training providers will be expected to adhere to this policy.
